LAYTON ROAD RENAMING FINALISED

The process to rename Argyle Road to Layton Road in Maryborough has now been finalised, with new street signage now in place.

The renamed section of road is located from Gillies Street, past the Maryborough Cemetery, to the Talisman Track intersection.

The road renaming was necessary due to works that changed the flow of traffic. Under the Geographic Place Names Act 1998 the road had to be renamed in the interests of public safety and in situations that could result in significant delays to essential services.

The name - Layton Road – was determined following a community consultation process.
