Council's slashing program is continuing this week in Wareek. Once complete, slashing will move back to Carisbrook and then Moolort.

Slashing is now complete in Majorca with this crew to move to Daisy Hill next, then on to Talbot.

Project update

Two new footpaths will be constructed in Maryborough starting this week:

- Napier Street from Derby Road to Clarke Street – 50 metres – underway
- Holyrood Street from Gladstone Street to Park Road – 450 metres – commencing Friday, 19 November.

The above projects have been made possible thanks to the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program.

In Dunolly, the finishing touches will be put on two new footpaths this week.

- Bull Street, between Market Street and Havelock Street – 300 metres.
- Market Street, from Bull Street to the Dunolly Swimming Pool – 100 metres

The Dunolly projects are funded as part of the 2021-2022 Council Budget.
