 - **Selection of Winner(s):** At the end of the competition period, the prize winner will be the image with the most public votes. The winner will be contacted in writing with further details.
 - **Prizes:** The image with the most public votes will win one (1) *Made in Maryborough* hamper to the value of \$100 from local Central Goldfields Shire businesses. This package will be delivered to the winner's nominated address.

Eligibility

- Participation in this Competition is open to persons of all ages.

- Participation open to amateur and professional photographers.
- Images can be taken on any device including phone, camera, drone etc.
- The image must include the All Things Gold Vic theme, this could include a golden sunset, the Golden Wattle, a gold nugget or just a 'golden' moment.
- Image must be of a place/location within the CGSC.
- Employees (and their immediate families) of the CGSC may contribute to the online campaign, but will not be eligible to enter the competition.
- The Central Goldfields Shire Council reserves the right, at any time, to verify the eligibility of an Entrant and to disqualify any Entrant that does not meet the Eligibility Criteria.
- An individual can enter multiple submissions.

How to Enter

1. Entrants may send an email with their image, as an attachment (JPEG) to events@cgoldshire.vic.gov.au or by uploading images to social media including the hashtag #allthingsgoldvic during the competition period. Entrants must include the location of the image and the relationship to All Things Gold Vic theme. The image must be taken within the CGSC.
2. To enter, eligible persons must complete the Entry Procedure during the Competition Period.
3. Entries not completed in accordance with these Terms and Conditions will be rejected and any late, incomplete, indecipherable or illegible Entries will be deemed invalid. Entries will be deemed accepted at the time of receipt by CGSC and not at the time of transmission.
4. The CGSC reserves the right to not display or delete an entry.

Consents and warranties on entry

- Entrants agree to their Entry being used by the CGSC in the future and grant them a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide, irrevocable and sub-licensable transferable licence to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish and display the Entry for any purpose in any media without compensation, restriction on use, attribution or liability. Entrants warrant that they have full authority to grant these rights and will not assert any moral rights in respect of the Entry.
- Entrants warrant and agree that:

- They will not submit, produce, upload or share any content that is fraudulent, or may be in breach of any intellectual property, privacy or other rights;
- No rights in the Entry have been previously granted to any person, corporation or entity;
