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1 Award Categories

Central Goldfields Shire Council Australia Day Awards recognise the contributions of outstanding Central Goldfields Shire residents, community events and community groups that, through hard work and determination, have significantly contributed to the community.

You can nominate a resident, community event or community group for Citizen of the Year, Young Citizen of the Year or Community Award of the Year. Fill in the attached nomination form for someone that makes you proud within the community.

1.1 Citizen of the Year

These prestigious awards are one of the highest honours Council can bestow to publicly acknowledge local heroes, whose dedication and contributions may otherwise go unnoticed.

1.1.1 Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Citizen of the Year Award, nominees must:

- Be an Australian Citizen;
- Be a resident of the Central Goldfields Shire Council area (when nominations close);
- Be 28 years of age or older on 26 January of the year the award is given;
- Not have received the same award in the past five years; and
- Not have been a Councillor in the past two years

1.1.2 Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria:

- Has made an outstanding contribution to the community in a voluntary capacity;
- Has been an inspiration/role model to the community; and
- Has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing the welfare and wellbeing of the community that have short or long-term benefits for others.

1.2 Young Citizen of the Year

Presented to a young person who has made an outstanding contribution to the community.

1.2.1 Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Young Citizen of the Year Award, nominees must:

- Be an Australian Citizen;
- Be a resident of the Central Goldfields Shire Council area (when nominations close);
- Be 27 years of age or younger on 26 January of the year the award is given;
- Not have received the same award in the past five years; and

- Not have been a Councillor in the past two years

1.2.2 Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria:

- Has made an outstanding contribution to the community in a voluntary capacity;
- Has been an inspiration/role model to the community; and
- Has shown achievements in community activities, academic, sporting, personal, cultural, environmental and/or social responsibility

1.3 Community Project or Event of the Year

Presented to a community group of four or more people.

1.3.1 Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Community Project or Event of the Year, the award must be for four or more people who conduct a successful not-for-profit project, event or activity, perform a service to the community, raise funds for a community charity, event or project, or bring recognition and credit to the community through a cultural, environmental or sporting achievement within the municipality of the Central Goldfields Shire Council.

The project or event is to:

- Have been completed (or the completion of a stage), or held in the year immediately before the award is given; and
- Not have received the award in the past five years

1.3.2 Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria:

- The purpose and outcomes of the event or project;
- The impact the event or project has/had on the community; and
- The ongoing benefit to the community Has made an outstanding contribution to the community in a voluntary capacity;

2 How to compile your nomination

Nominations must be submitted on the official Central Goldfields Shire Council Australia Day Awards

Nomination Form (online or hard copy).

The answer to the question, "Why are you nominating this person/project/event?" requires a minimum of 100 words. Include as much detail as you can in this section as this forms the majority of the material to be assessed by the judging panel.

Additional details can be included in a separate document along with details/copies of any other awards or supporting documents (i.e. newspaper or magazine articles about the Nominee and their achievements).

Please provide all required information on the nomination form. Failure to provide complete information may result in the nomination not being considered.

2.1 Tips for writing a nomination

2.1.1 Open with the important information

Provide clear and specific statements that outline why your nominee is worthy of an Australia Day Award. What activities or actions stand out, what have they accomplished that makes a difference in the community? How do they inspire or motivate others in the community?

2.1.2 Consider your audience

Spell out acronyms and avoid using jargon, overly complex language or terms that may not be familiar to the general public.

2.1.3 Share their story

Tell us about the person behind the nomination. What motivates them to make a difference? What personal challenges have they overcome in their life? Why do they inspire others? How does this person make you feel? Use real-world examples that demonstrate why your nominee is an inspiring role model. We want to know the stories of their life and the impact they have made

2.1.4 Stick to the selection criteria

Our panel is looking for people who make a significant voluntary contribution to our community, who are role models, and who have demonstrated a strong commitment to improving the short or long term wellbeing of others, so ensure your nomination addresses these criteria.

2.1.5 Tell the facts

Support your nomination with hard facts and reliable statistics. Can you provide specific measures of this person's success? Attach copies of newspaper or magazine articles or other supporting documentation.

2.1.6 Aim for quality, not quantity

A long nomination isn't always a better nomination. Try to keep your sentences short and concise, and avoid repetition.

2.1.7 Remember referees

Don't forget to fill in the referee field, naming someone else that supports your nomination, who is aware of the nominee's achievements and will be able to provide any additional information if required

3 Conditions of entry

- All nominations must be received 5pm Friday 5 November 2021
- Nominations must be on the official form, hard copy or online.
- One nomination per form.
- The name of at least one referee must be supplied. This person may be contacted if the nominee is shortlisted.
- All nomination information and material submitted remains the property of Central Goldfields Shire Council.
- The decision of Central Goldfields Shire Council in relation to the awards is final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect to the decision.
- Additional information which supports the nomination, such as newspaper articles can be attached to the form.

4 Selection process

Following the close of nominations, the Australia Day Awards Selection Panel will score nominations based on the Selection Criteria.

In the event that no nominations are received in any of the categories, the Australia Day Awards Selection Panel reserves the right to grant the award to a group, project/event or citizen of its choice.

The decision of the Australia Day Awards Selection Panel is final and no additional correspondence will be entered in to.

5 Award Ceremony

Award recipients are announced on 26 January 2022. All nominees and nominators will be invited to attend the award announcements (subject to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions).
