




CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE:

This structure is an excellent example of the quite substantial engineering structures constructed out of local stone during the 19th and early 20th centuries to serve public needs, in this case water supply. Apart from its historic significance, this channel is also a significant component in the immediate landscape. The only comparable structures in the district are the stone lined stormwater drainage channels in Maryborough.

HISTORY:

Original Use: Part of Carisbrook's water supply system.

Present Use: Disused

DESCRIPTION:

Basically U-shaped, bluestone lined channel, some 2 metres wide and deep.

CONSERVATION GUIDELINES:

Keep intact.

Regular maintenance as necessary.

Regulate the immediate surroundings of the channel to ensure that it is not threatened.

Work on forming and lining the natural watercourse to become Maryborough's main drain began with a £1,000 government grant, obtained largely by the ex-Mayor W.M. Page.<sup>2</sup> Completed by 1880, this fourteen feet wide drain was then extended through Princes Park at a width of twenty-one feet at a cost of £1,000 paid by the Borough Council.<sup>2</sup> In 1885 the Blackman's Lead drain junction was completed, followed by construction from the Majorca Road in 1888, the latter paid for by a Government grant and £200 from the Railways Department.<sup>2</sup> 1896 saw the drain extended to Brougham Street and completion to its present extent in 1898.<sup>3</sup>

A much earlier Maryborough drain was laid from the intersection of Nolan and High Streets to Alma Street. Construction was in ironbark timber.

DESCRIPTION:

These drains are constructed mostly in local sandstone with brick centre sections.






CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE:

The local sandstone, bluestone and brick lined drains that pass through the City are the natural creek beds lined to serve the town's stormwater needs. They are good examples of local public engineering works from the second half of the nineteenth century and illustrate the readily adaptive nature of Victorian settlers at that time. The drains are mostly open and the main one passes through Phillips Gardens, the Botanic Gardens. The two main drains join in Princes Park. Thus they are also landscape and garden elements, as well as components of some streetscapes. Evidently Maryborough gaol prisoners were used to quarry some of the stone.<sup>1</sup>



constructed (q.v.).<sup>1</sup> Leaks were discovered in 1883 and 1886 (in 1993 the reservoir has at least one leak). Incrustation of the pipes during the 1890s led to supply problems and a Royal Commission recommended the installation of new nine (225 mm) and eight inch (200 mm) diameter pipes were laid into the service basin.<sup>2</sup> The mains were scraped and in 1898-1899 a new main was installed?

DESCRIPTION:

Rammed solid concrete reservoir wall, bluestone capped, stone spillway. Cast reinforced concrete outlet tower constructed this century. The excavated concrete mixing platform remains cut into the nearby bank and there is another much smaller excavation close by. Probably originally one Elm tree is now surrounded by numerous suckers and on the eastern bank near the dam wall are a number of mature pine trees; they were more extensive, but a number have been cut down.
