


**NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION
FOR A PLANNING PERMIT**

The land affected by the application is located at:	25 Craigie Park Road, Craigie (Craigie Park Reserve)
The application is for a permit to:	Use and development of land for a horse-riding school including associated buildings and works.
A permit is required under the following clauses of the planning scheme:	
<i>Planning scheme clause</i>	<i>Matter for which a permit is required</i>
36.02-1 (PPRZ) <i>Public Park and Recreation Zone</i>	Use land for “any other use not in Section 3” (being a horse-riding school) where the condition is not met (the use is not to be conducted by or on behalf of the public land manager).
36.02-2 (PPRZ) <i>Public Park and Recreation Zone</i>	Construct a building or construct or carry out works.
44.01-2 (EMO) <i>Erosion Management Overlay</i>	Construct a building or construct or carry out works.
36.02-2 (SMO) <i>Salinity Management Overlay</i>	Construct a building or construct or carry out works.
The applicant for the permit is:	Riding for the Disabled Association of Victoria
The application reference number is:	084-25

This can be done during office hours and is free of charge.

Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the responsible authority. An objection must be made to the responsible authority in writing, include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected.

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available at its office for any person to inspect during office hours free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.
