Moving Messages

Our team is spreading the word far and wide about the value of our recycled waste and how to sort it. The Victorian Government requires standardisation of the bin waste system across the state by July 2027

The only major change will be the separation of glass from the recycling bin to improve the efficiency of processing for re-use. In the meantime, there's lots of little things we can do to help, like

- Keeping e-waste and batteries out of household bins
- Ensuring recycle bins are not packed too tight
- Washing out containers before disposal
