What is involved

Council is seeking a community group for the cleaning and restocking of permanent toilet and showers across the Princes Park event site during the EB.

Tasks

Toilets & Showers

- Clean/sanitise toilets and showers
- Fill toilet paper dispensers
- Fill paper towel dispensers
- Sweep area
- Remove rubbish
- Mop if necessary

1. Princes Park Grandstand Clubrooms (4 toilets and 8 showers)
2. Ladies Brick Toilets behind Princes Park Grandstand (12 toilets)
3. Men's Brick Toilets North of Princes Park Grandstand (8 toilets)
4. Princes Park Netball Court Changerooms (2 toilets and two showers)
5. Track 2 changerooms and toilets (6 toilets and 4 showers)
6. Adventure Playground Toilets (5 toilets)
7. Jubilee Oval Clubrooms (5 toilets)
8. MFNC upstairs social rooms ladies (three toilets) and men's toilets (two toilets)
9. Maryborough Outdoor Pool Changerooms (Ladies 3 Toilets + 3 Showers) (Mens 1 Toilet, 1 Urinal + 3 Showers)
