

Central Goldfields Youth Council 2022 – 23 Priorities Action Plan

Education and Aspiration

Aims:

- Breaking down the (perceived and real) rivalry and stigma between Highview and MEC secondary schools
- Help young people in Central Goldfields get a better idea of career pathways
- Find a way for the schools to offer classes and courses that aren't currently available to one / both schools
- Advocate to address other barriers to education in Central Goldfields, e.g. lack of high quality internet coverage, low class numbers, poor public transport

ACTIONS:

- Youth Councillors:
 - Work together to develop a proposal that can be presented to the Principals / SRCs of Highview and MEC.
- Staff:
 - Gemma to find information about programs for industry alumni to hold presentations about their career paths, plus a coordinated careers program for young people to try out different careers / roles.

Respect, Tolerance, Awareness and Acceptance

Aims:

 Explore ways to promote inclusion and break down prejudice in the community in Central Goldfields Shire- including for groups such as people who identify as LGBTIQA+, people from culturally, linguistically, or ethnically diverse backgrounds, First Nations people, and people with a disability

ACTIONS:

- Youth Councillors:
 - o Connect with Maryborough Pride Festival 2023 organisers
 - Hold a separate brainstorm session to explore specific outcomes Youth Council would like to achieve in this priority area

Climate Change and the Environment

Aims:

- Educate and encourage young people in Central Goldfields to participate in fighting climate change / helping the environment
- Participate in or promote projects such as:
 - o Reforestation planting trees and regenerating environments
 - Community rubbish clean up / pick up days
 - Advocating for improved local recycling facilities
 - o Fundraiser events to plant more trees
 - Advocating to local representatives or members of parliament



ACTIONS:

- Youth Councillors:
 - Participate in October Climate Conversations Month with Tony Macer
 - Hold a community clean up day through partnership with Clean Up Australia Day, and advertise it to the community through channels such as sporting clubs, schools, and noticeboards

More for Youth To Do

Aims:

- Advocate for / help to plan more activities for young people to do in Central Goldfields, with greater variety, and low or no ticket cost
- Promote information about / plan social events for rural and farming young people, including social gatherings and relevant information sessions (e.g. agricultural skills courses)
- Run surveys / other opportunities for young people to provide information about what they want

ACTIONS:

- Youth Councillors:
 - Work with staff to plan a youth music festival / concert event

Youth Hub

Aims:

- Advocate for the opening of an appropriate Youth Hub facility in Maryborough
- Work with staff to ensure a Youth Hub meets the needs of young people and includes their ideas for their facility

ACTIONS:

- Staff:
 - Organise a Youth Hub brainstorm workshop for young people in partnership with Youth Council, to be held at the end of the year (November, after exams)
 - Set up an online survey for young people to provide feedback about what they would like in a Youth Hub
